

# How to clean your PVC Venetian Blinds

## What you need

- A microfiber cloth
- A duster and dusting spray
- Warm soapy water
- Vinegar

## Easy Cleaning Tips

Incredibly durable and much lower maintenance than their elegant finish would lead you to believe, PVC venetian blinds are a lazy girl's dream. If you're not into spending all your time on cleaning, then PVC Venetian's are an easy, breezy window solution. They require only minimal time and effort to keep them looking fabulous. Here are a few easy cleaner tips to make it simple:

- Rotate the slats during cleaning to ensure every angle is dusted
- You can also use a microfiber cloth or the brush attachment of your vacuum to gather dust
- To remove dirt and sticky build up or prevent future dust, spray your duster or microfiber cloth with dusting spray and wipe down the slats.
- Alternatively, you can also dip your microfiber cloth in soapy water and scrub slats

- To disinfect your blinds, make a 1 to 1 solution of vinegar and water and wipe your blinds down with the solution

## Operating your blinds

- Pull the tilt control cord to rotate the slats to your lighting and privacy requirements
- Pull the lift control cord down to raise the slats (assist with hand under the bottom bar for large blinds)
- Angle the cord to the side of the blind and release to lock it at the desired height
- Pull down towards the centre of the blind to release the cords to lift or lower the blind
- Hold down clips provided can be installed to keep the bottom rail in position. Gently push the bottom rail towards the hold down clip and pull the bottom rail away from the other end in order to release the bottom rail from the hold down clips

## Cleaning your PVC Venetian Blinds

One of the great benefits of owning PVC Venetian blinds is that they are extremely durable and easy to clean. This is owing to the fact that you can use water on your PVC blinds! Unlike timber or fabric options, your PVC blinds will not become damaged from absorbing water nor will they ever require costly dry-cleaning. Read our instructions for cleaning below:

1. Tilt the slats of your blinds upwards and dust each individually with a duster and dusting spray, you can try with your vacuum to get the window sill and some of the smaller crevices of your blinds
2. Turn the blinds downwards and gently dust the other side
3. To remove sticky residue or dirt build up, spray your microfiber cloth with dusting spray and wipe down the slats
4. For very dusty blinds, use soapy water and a damp cloth to scrub individual slats, moving from top to bottom
5. Allow your blinds to air dry with the slats open
