

How to clean your Roller Blinds

Roller blinds are a stylish and practical choice for your windows, but like most blinds, they can collect dust and grime and become dirty without proper care. The great thing about your roller blinds is that they only need minimal cleaning and maintenance to keep them looking great. What you need

- A vacuum with a soft bristle attachment
- A microfiber cloth
- Warm soapy water

Easy Cleaning Tips

Here are a few easy cleaning tips that you should keep in mind when cleaning your roller blinds. These tips will help you to avoid damaging your window coverings and make it a much faster job.

- Roller fabrics should only be dusted with the vacuum by sweeping across the blind while you support from the back - this will prevent the fabric from being crumpled and sucked into the hose.
- Use a soft brush attachment on your vacuum to help pick up dust and protect your fabric
- Use the low suction setting on your vacuum if you have one
- Fabric should not be cleaned with water
- Finger marks and spots can be cleaned by wiping with a damp cloth.

- To remove stains, you can spot clean with a micro fiber cloth and warm soapy water. Dab the stain to remove.
- For more stubborn stains, a specialist fabric stain remover might be required to be applied.
- Use a clean microfiber cloth to completely dry the stain and prevent water rings or water lines.

Preparing your Roller Blinds

- Lower your blinds by operating the chain to lower your blinds
- Important tip: never pull on the actual blinds or bottom bar to lower or raise your blinds

Cleaning your Roller Blinds

The steps involved in cleaning your roller blinds are actually super simple. Regular weekly blinds cleaning and maintenance will help to reduce the time you need to spend on keeping your roller blinds looking great. Follow these easy steps;

1. Vacuum your blinds to remove any dust or dirt build up - don't forget to ensure that the back is supported and that you vacuum in a sweeping motion across your blinds.
2. Turn your blinds around and vacuum the opposite side
3. Remove any finger marks or stains with some warm water and a damp microfiber cloth
4. Vacuum any dust or dirt that might have fallen onto your window sill
5. If your blinds have been left for a long time without cleaning or maintenance and are too dirty to be cleaned with a vacuum and cloth, you may need to take them into a professional drycleaner

General tips

- If over time the sidewinder control mechanism becomes noisy or stiff, use a Silicone spray to lubricate.

When properly cared for, roller blinds make excellent window coverings. They come in a seemingly endless variety of colours and patterns and can be used to completely update the look of your home and reflect your personality.
